

Costs On Optional Treatments:

We want to be very clear about what is and is not included with the fee paid to Camelot Cancer Care, so there is a clear understanding and patients are never surprised by what could be perceived as hidden charges. The standard DMSO-based intravenous formula we administer over 20 days consists of beet-derived high dose Vitamin C, Vitamin B17 (also known as Amygdalin, the generic term for Laetrile) with a small amount of dextrose to serve as the 'bait' for the cancer. These additives all bind with the DMSO, which delivers them into the malignancy. Patients who request sodium bicarbonate will receive a full round of it via nebulizer inhalation, included at no extra charge.

When a new patient arrives at Camelot Cancer Care, they are given a one-month supply of the Core Vitamin & Mineral Supplement, which is included in the cost of initial treatment; refills may be purchased from Camelot Cancer Care if the patient wishes. The cost of your initial exam and consultation with our doctor is also included.

The following services are at additional cost but may be covered by your insurance. Please note that Camelot does not file any insurance paperwork, so it will be up to you or the provider to do so.

- \$1,500.00 for self-pay (uninsured) pre and/or post treatment PET scan
- \$50 house call (each time), if patient is unable to come to the clinic for treatment
- \$163.25 for initial lab work (Covered by most insurance): Full chemistry panel, CBC & differential & special enzyme test to see if you can have intravenous vitamin C without risk of anemia *
- \$70.00 (35.00 weekly X2) for CBC after the first week *
- \$50 (approximately) for chest X-ray to verify correct picc line placement **

* These costs are only incurred if you do not have insurance or if your insurance does not cover this service

** This cost is only incurred if you have a picc line placed in our facility

The treatments listed below are optional and may or may not be available to you based on your medical history, lab results, and current condition. These optional treatments are all explained in detail within the laminated pages of the binder kept in the infusion room. These are all potent weapons in the alternative arsenal.

1. Immune boosting supplements consisting of:
 - a. Vitamin D3 (10,000 IU daily) *
 - b. Selenium (250-400 Mcg daily) *
 - c. Iodoral (12.5 mg per tablet)
 - d. Omega 3 Fish Oil (3,000 mg daily)
 - e. Drenamin/Adrenal support
 - f. Core Vitamin & Mineral Supplement

* Included in the core Vitamin/Mineral Supplement

2. Hyperthermia/sauna treatment (if normal BP) - \$40 per treatment (30 min ea)
3. Methylglyoxal - \$260 per bottle (1 month supply, taken orally)
4. Photoluminescence (Ultraviolet Blood Irradiation) - \$300 per treatment
5. Coley's Toxins (I.V.; requires close monitoring for 7 hrs) - \$750 per treatment
6. Meyer's Cocktail with Glutathione \$200 / without Glutathione \$150
7. Ozonated Olive Oil (topical) - \$20 per 2oz jar
8. Subsequent rounds of treatment after your initial 20-day round is completed - administered at Camelot or by yourself or a caregiver at home -\$3,600 + shipping if sent to you anywhere outside the Camelot facility.
9. Electro-magnetic Frequency treatment – request information upon arrival.
